Nsw & Act Four Wheel Drive Association Jamboree 2018 Terms and Conditions





Thank you for your interest in the 2018 Jamboree

The Organisers, 4WD NSW & ACT, hereinafter called the Association, and Black Diamond Recreational 4WD Club Inc, hereinafter called the Club, wish to provide a weekend of fun, safe and family-friendly 4WD activities. In the interests of everyone's safety and enjoyment, all attendees must agree to the following Terms & Conditions. Failure to adhere to these Terms & Conditions will lead to eviction from the site, with no refund of any fees paid.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

On entering the site, attendees are deemed to have accepted the following Terms & Conditions.

- Attendees agree to comply with all signs and reasonable instructions issued by event officials and NSW
 Police and act in a socially acceptable manner at all times. Police officers may patrol the site at any time
 and issue infringements for traffic (including blood alcohol limits) and other offences.
- Attendance is restricted to financial members of clubs which are affiliated with the Association.
- The following are expressly banned from the venue:
 - Illegal substances including illicit drugs
 - Weapons of any sort
 - Glass containers of any sort
 - Pyrotechnics (fireworks)
 - o Chainsaws
 - Animals and pets (other than registered assistance dogs)
 - o Fires (other than gas BBQ's, charcoal bead BBQ's and similar off-the-ground fires eg OzPig) (There will be one communal fire.)
 - Motorcycles, whether registered or not, excluding mobility aids. (exemption for entertainment display purposes)
- All persons and their vehicles and possessions may be subject to searches before entering the Site and
 at any time. Persons who refuse to participate may be denied entry or asked to leave the Site. Any
 person having entered the Site and found to be in possession of a Prohibited or Restricted Item, shall
 have such item confiscated and may be evicted from the Site and/or handed over to NSW Police.
 Confiscated Prohibited or Restricted Items may be subsequently destroyed by a relevant Authority.
- All vehicles on the site must be registered to be driven on NSW roads and be in a roadworthy condition.
 No vehicles may be trailered onto the site.
- Any person driving a vehicle on the Site must be licenced to drive on NSW roads and obey all NSW road
 rules at all times. A speed limit of 5 km/h applies across the whole site with the only exception being
 for the purpose of approved scheduled site events
- Attendees will be issued with a coloured wristband which must be worn for the duration of the Event.
- The Organisers reserve the right to refuse entry to or evict any attendee from the Site who:
 - o breaches these Terms & Conditions or whom the Organisers have reasonable grounds to believe is likely to breach these Terms & Conditions
 - o jeopardises safety or security at the Site
 - o is deemed to be intoxicated or disorderly or under the influence of drugs;
 - o attempts to bring in, or is found in possession of, Prohibited or Restricted Items;
 - engages in a Prohibited or Restricted Activity;
 - o fails to comply with lawful directions by the Organisers, Event Officials or NSW Police;
 - o is not authorised to be on Site; e.g. without a valid entry ticket (wristband).

- Any Attendee who breaches these Terms & Conditions may also be subject to disciplinary action from their own club.
- Persons under the age of 18 years (Minors) will not be permitted to enter and remain on site unless
 accompanied by a Responsible Adult. A Responsible Adult in relation to a Minor, means an adult who
 is a parent, step-parent or guardian of the Minor. A Responsible Adult must not be intoxicated when
 on Site and takes the responsibility to ensure that no alcohol is consumed by the Minor they are
 supervising at any time whilst on site.
- Learner Permit holders under certain conditions will be allowed to participate in scheduled Events.
- All persons entering the Site are advised that they are entering a non-licensed site and anyone who consumes alcohol must do so responsibly.
- Consumption of alcohol by Minors will not be tolerated. Anyone who looks under 25 and is drinking on site may be asked for proof of age by the Organisers, Event Officials or NSW Police.
- Photographs taken within the Site may be used only for private non-commercial purposes. Making or distributing of broadcasts, commentary, news reports or statistics (by any means including by mobile phone or other wireless device) is prohibited.
- Attendees grant the Organisers the non-exclusive right to use their image and likeness in any form or medium, as part of any broadcast or recording of the Event and for any other commercial purposes (including in advertising and promotional materials).
- Campsites campsites will open no earlier than midday Thursday 29th March 2018, and close no later than midday Tuesday 3rd April 2018. Attendees will not be provided access outside this timeframe under any circumstance. All persons entering the Site are advised that:
 - o campsites must be left in an acceptable state when departing;
 - o caravans, campervans and camper trailers are not to dump waste and sewage on the Site.
- Liability Participation in and/or viewing of motor sport activities can be dangerous and may result in injury or death.
 - o Attendees participating in or viewing such activities acknowledge they do so at their own risk.
 - Attendees bringing personal property, including motor vehicles, onto the Site acknowledge they do so at their own risk and assume all risk for any damage or loss (including property damage, personal injury, economic and consequential loss) however it arises at the Site.
 - The Organisers will not be held responsible for any damage to, loss or theft of an attendee's personal property.
 - To the extent permitted by law, attendees release the Association and its member clubs, its contractors and agents and their directors, officers, employees, consultants, contractors, teams and drivers, agents and volunteers, and the owners, management and staff of the venue (hereinafter called the Promoter Group) from any liability for any damages, loss, liability or injury they may suffer or incur relating to or arising out of their attendance at the event and within the Site however caused, including, without limitation due to any negligence or other act or omission of the Promoter Group.
- **Prohibited Items** The following is a non-exhaustive list of items that are prohibited by law and are not permitted to enter the Site:
 - o illegal substances including controlled, dangerous or illicit drugs;
 - o explosives, flares, fireworks, laser pointers, smoke bombs or weapons.
- Restricted Items The following items are considered restricted and are not permitted to enter the Site:

- o excessive quantities of alcoholic beverages as deemed by the organizers to exceed the accommodation of moderate consumption;
- o glass bottles, breakable containers including wine and beer bottles/drinking vessels, jars and any other containers or items made of glass;
- o missiles of any description;
- o chainsaws;
- o motor bikes, quad bikes or similar motorised transportation vehicles; (exemption for entertainment display purposes)
- animals and pets (other than registered assistance dogs);
- o platforms, structures or materials to be used to erect raised seating or other viewing platforms;
- o signs, banners, flags and clothing displaying offensive, political, national, racial or unauthorised commercial material;
- o any item determined by the Organisers that may cause injury, public nuisance, or will obstruct the view or jeopardise the safety, comfort or experience of other attendees.
- **Prohibited/Restricted Activities** The following is a non-exhaustive list of activities that are restricted or prohibited on Site and participation in such activities may result in eviction from the Site:
 - o consumption of controlled, dangerous or illicit drugs;
 - o inappropriate or unsafe use of a motor vehicle within the Site on or off designated roadways;
 - o Enter or attempt to enter Competition Courses or out of bounds areas without authorisation.
 - displaying offensive or unauthorised commercial signage;
 - o throwing objects of any description;
 - o quarrelsome and disorderly behaviour;
 - o offensive or racist language;
 - o unauthorised soliciting and customer surveying;
 - o misuse, deface, damage, remove from the Site or tamper with or attempt to misuse, deface, damage, remove from the Site or tamper with any building, barricade, seat, chair, toilet, sink, table structure, vehicle, craft, truck, pipe, tap or fitting, conduit, electrical equipment, wiring or sign or excavate or cause to be excavated any part of the area within the Site;
 - deposit litter, except in a receptacle provided for that purpose;
 - o interfere with, obstruct or hinder Event Officials or any authorised person in the exercise of their powers, functions or duties.
